

ANNEX FR - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ccTLD .FR / .RE / .PM / .TF / .WF / .YT

In addition to the general terms and conditions CG-ND, the registration and use of a Domain Name under these Extensions implies the acceptance and respect of these special terms and conditions CP-ND-FR.

All terms employed in these special terms and conditions beginning with a capital letter are to be interpreted in compliance with the definition assigned to them in the general terms and conditions CG-ND.

SECTION FR.1: TRUSTEE AUTHORITY AND REGISTRY

FR.1.1 FranceDNS is a member of AFNIC and act as an official registrar for the management of domain names under these Extensions.

SECTION FR.2: REGISTRATION REGULATIONS

FR.2.1 Domain Names under these Extensions are registered on a "*first come, first served*" basis, unless exception made by AFNIC concerning terms subject to prior review.

FR.2.2 The Client declares and guarantees that the Domain Name respects the rights of third-parties, currently applicable laws as well as regulations specific to these Extensions, which can be consulted at the following addresses:

The Client agrees to have read and approved this contractual document (below, the "FR Regulations") which links him to the Registry. The present special terms do not substitute these regulations which are integrated by means of a hyperlink.

SECTION FR.3: SPECIAL REQUIEREMENTS

FR.3.1 Regarding FR Regulations, the owner and administrative contact must reside in a state member of European Union or in Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland.

FR.3.2 Regarding FR Regulations, the name servers (DNS) of the domain name must be correctly configured as specified in the Registry's technical specifications

This point must be verified in order to perform the following operations: registration, transfer, trade, nameservers change.

SECTION FR.4: TRANSFER REGULATIONS

FR.4.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of FranceDNS, a transfer request (also referred to as "change of delegation") for a Domain Name under these Extensions from another registrar to FranceDNS according to the procedure specified on our site, and in compliance with FR Regulations:

FR.4.2 The client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must provide a valid authorization code to FranceDNS. Otherwise the transfer cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from FranceDNS

FR.4.3 When the transfer is completed, the anniversary date of the Domain Name is changed to the effective date of transfer, then the domain is valid for 1 year.

FR.4.4 In the case of a transfer to another Registrar (also referred to as "transfer out"), the authorization code may be requested to FranceDNS and will be emailed to the Client's email address. The Client must also ensure that the protection of the Domain Name is disabled.

FR.4.5 A protection against transfers is proposed. This lock protects Domain Names managed by FranceDNS against any request for transfer to another Registrar.

SECTION FR.5: CHANGE of OWNERSHIP REGULATIONS

FR.5.1 The Client initiates, through the intermediary of FranceDNS, a request for a change of ownership for a Domain Name under these Extensions.

FR.5.2 The change does not take effect immediately. The Client must follow the described procedure and, particularly, must approve the transfer to the registry following a format specified on the Registry's Website.

FR.5.3 If the Client refuses or does not approve the change of ownership according to the terms stipulated by the Registry, the change cannot be proceeded with and the Client may not claim any compensation or refund from FranceDNS

FR.5.4 When transfer of ownership is completed, the anniversary date of the Domain Name is changed to the effective date of transfer, then the domain is valid for 1 year.

FR.5.5 The transfer of ownership can also be done in conjunction with a change of Registrar in the same operation. Therefore, the rules of transfer of ownership applies.

SECTION FR.6: EXPIRY / RESTORATION REGULATIONS

FR.6.1 When the Domain Name's expiry date has passed without prior renewal by the Client, FranceDNS shall submit a request for the deletion of the Domain Name to the Registry. The Domain Name shall be referred to as in "redemption" status for a period of thirty (30) calendar days.

FR.6.2 If a Domain Name has been destroyed with the past thirty (30) calendar days, it can be registered again subject to the following conditions and procedures, and depending on the details provided to FranceDNS when carrying out these procedures:

- i) restoration is only possible from a technical point of view for the so-called "redemption" period, which is the seven (7) day period between the destruction of the Domain Name by the Registry and its liberation.
- ii) only FranceDNS has the possibility to register the Domain Name during the redemption period.
- iii) payment for the restoration must be made at least (2) days before the liberation of the Domain Name by the Registry, to enable FranceDNS to carry out the operation within the time limit. Failing this, the Domain Name might not be restored and FranceDNS cannot be held responsible on these grounds.
- iv) the restoration procedure restores the Domain Name's previous parameters (personal and technical information) and extends by one (1) year the duration of the Domain Name's registration starting from the new date of registration.

SECTION FR.7: CONTRACTUAL AMENDMENTS FOR SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FR.7.1 FR Regulation laid down by the Trustee Authority and the Registry are subject to change. These changes, linked to the naming system for these extensions are imposed by the Registry in charge of these Extensions and represent changes that are not beyond FranceDNS's control.
